We understand that surrendering your bird is a difficult choice to make, but often times can be avoided with support. We offer a variety of resources and services that may help to keep you and your bird together such as:

- ★ Support group
- ★ Boarding/hardship boarding
- ★ Diet conversions
- ★ Foraging, enrichment activities to keep them busy
- ★ Handling techniques so they can't bite you
- ★ Training (we work with Animal Behavior Center)
- ★ Education
- ★ Thinking outside the box

If you do not feel that any of the above resources may be applicable to you, please proceed with completing the Surrender Agreement. By doing so, you understand that all available options from PRH have been explained to you for the avoidance of surrendering and that you are releasing your bird completely voluntarily and that no representations, considerations, or promises of any kind have been made to you by PRH or any of its representatives.

The following form is a legally binding document for the irrevocable surrender of your bird to PRH.

The name of Papayago Rescue House, Inc., shall hereinafter be referred to as "PRH".

PRH has my permission to contact my veterinarian for any necessary information pertaining to my Bird, and I hereby consent to the release of any and all medical information by any medical provider.

I hereby release and forever discharge PRH from any and all rights, claims, obligations, liabilities, and causes of action whatsoever arising out of or relating to the ownership, possession, or disposition of the Bird, and I agree to indemnify and hold harmless PRH from and against any and all such rights, claims, obligations, liabilities, and causes of action which may be asserted by third parties.
